

## MISSION

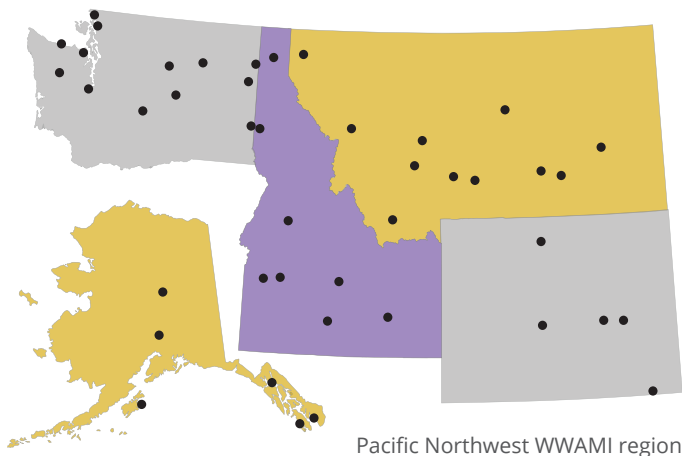

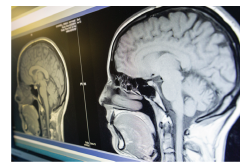
