MISSION

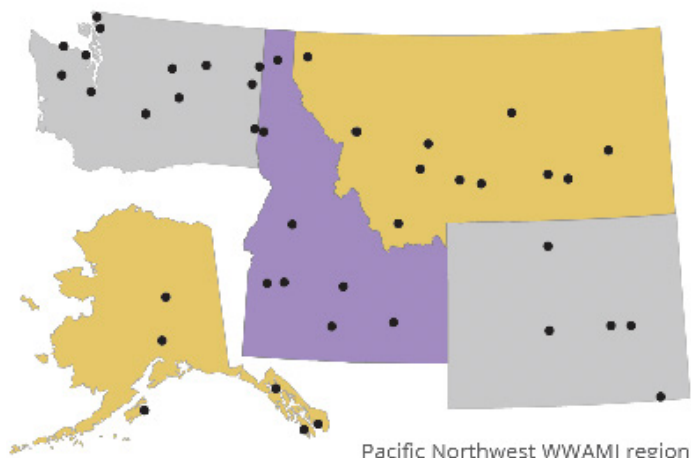
